2014 UVU Cello Fest Competition

The 2014 UVU Cello Fest Competition takes place on Saturday Oct 11th, 2014. It consists of two categories one each for High School (Grades 9-12 or Ages 14 to 17) and Junior High School (Grades 7-8 or Ages 12 to 13) age groups. Cellists under the appropriate age groups are eligible to apply. One winner from each age group will be chosen. Each winner will receive a gift certificate from Summerhays Music and will perform in the culmination concert on the same day alongside performances by Mr. Marleyn, Utah cello teachers and cello choirs.

Competition Rules:

- The competition is open to any cellists meeting the age requirements of the High School and Junior High School categories.
- A maximum of 12 entrants will be admitted to compete in each category of competition (12 for High School category and 12 for Junior High School category). Entrants will be chosen based on recommendation of the entrant's cello teacher or ensemble director and by the order the applications will be received.
- Entrant's selected work shall be at least four (4) minutes and no longer than eight (8) minutes.
- The maximum *audition* time in the Competition is five (5) minutes. Entrants should select for the audition a representation from the entire work that best represents both their abilities and significant features of the music to be performed.
- Any work for solo cello or cello and accompaniment (piano or piano reduction) is acceptable for performance.
- Any contestant who is unable to attend the Competition for any reason will be disqualified. No make-ups are allowed.
- Students must provide two copies of their musical selection for jury members.
- The competition will be open to the public.
- If the entrant's selection requires an accompanying pianist, the entrant must provide his or her own pianist.
- The results of the Competition will be announced by a representative of the jury immediately after the competition. The deliberations of the jury are confidential and all decisions are final.
